

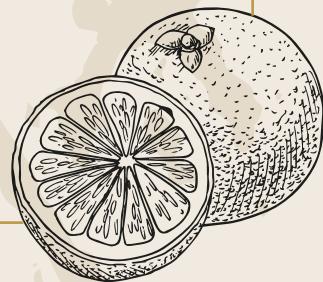

STRAND STATION

One of a handful of disused Tube stations hidden beneath London, Aldwych - known by the sign above its red-tiled entrance as Strand - has seen more camera crews than commuters since it closed in 1994. A deserted time capsule, the eerily empty station now stars as a film and TV location, featuring in Sherlock, Superman, 28 Weeks Later, Darkest Hour, Atonement and more.

Flavour Profile - Citrus forward, slightly herbal, a hint of smokiness and a touch of salt

Ingredients - Havana Rum, Rose Shrub, Averna, Spicy Mango

THE STRAND MAGAZINE

Published from 1891 to 1950, The Strand Magazine turned everyday London into a literary hotspot. The popularity of Sherlock Holmes became widespread after it first appeared in its pages, with the magazine amassing half a million eager readers. This cocktail is a tribute to that golden age of storytelling, a toast to the narratives that made The Strand come to life.

Flavour Profile - Light and citrusy with floral notes, a touch of sweetness, and a herbal finish

Ingredients - Citrus Vodka, Limoncello, St. Germain Elderflower, Antica Formula, Sapphire

REBEL WAT TYLER

Leader of the peasant revolt of 1381, Wat Tyler led a rebellion against a punishing poll tax and a system that kept people tied to their birth. His army of peasants stormed London, torched the Savoy Palace, and forced a face-to-face with the teenage King Richard II. Spoiler: it didn't end well for Tyler. This cocktail raises a glass to revolution, with no need to pledge fealty first.

Flavour Profile - A bold blend of citrus and berries balanced with bourbon smoke

Ingredients - Bulleit Bourbon, Lime, Sugar, Rose Shrub, Angostura bitters, Red Wine, Cherry

LE STYLE MODERNE

In the roaring 1920s, Strand Palace got a dazzling Art Deco makeover - complete with a foyer so iconic, the V&A Museum snapped it up for their collection. Known then as Le Style Moderne, this was the golden age of cocktails, chrome, and late nights dressed to the nines. This cocktail is a nod to that era of bold design and bright lights.

Flavour Profile - Light, sparkling, with soft notes of vanilla and brandy

Ingredients - Courvoisier, Ginger Syrup, Heering Cherry, Red Wine

1909

In Edwardian London, a grand new hotel opened its doors on the Strand in 1909. Five shillings and sixpence got you a room and breakfast. Since then, we've seen monarchs crowned, wars fought, and decades of guests pass through - artists, icons, dreamers, and doers. This cocktail - made using Strand Palace's own bespoke gin - celebrates where it all started: one address, over a century of stories, and a city we'll never stop raising a glass to.

Flavour Profile - Bright and refreshing, with fresh berries, citrus and Strand's signature gin

Ingredients - Strand Palace Gin, Tanqueray No. 10, Raspberry Syrup, Elderflower Syrup, Cranberry Juice, Orange Bitters, Pink Grapefruit Soda

THE OLIVER BERNARD

British Architect Oliver Bernard didn't just design a hotel; he designed an experience. In the 1930s, he transformed the entrance of the Strand Palace with iconic Art Deco details, including revolving doors - now safely housed at the V&A Museum. This cocktail is our tribute to Bernard's bold vision that made Strand Palace a beacon of style and a firm fixture on London's fashionable social scene.

Flavour Profile - Refreshing pineapple and coconut with a twist of citrus and ginger for balance

Ingredients - Malibu, Wray & Nephew Rum, Pineapple & Ginger Shrub, Pineapple Juice, Lime Juice, Coconut Syrup

MURDER MYSTERY

In the post-war 1940s, Strand Palace found itself in the middle of a real-life murder mystery. Staff burst into a room to find Neville Heath standing over a distressed young woman named Pauline. Months later, when Heath was arrested for a separate murder, staff mistakenly identified the victim as Pauline - a twist that added confusion (and headlines) to one of London's most notorious true crime tales.

Flavour Profile - Berry-forward with a slightly fizzy, foamy finish

Ingredients - Ciroc Apple Vodka, Ciroc Vodka, Raspberry Syrup, Elderflower Cordial, Cranberry Juice

THE POWDER ROOM

In 1958, Strand Palace gave London hospitality a glow-up, becoming one of the first hotels in the city to offer en-suite bathrooms. No more hallway dashes in a robe to use the shared bathrooms on each floor - just the luxury of pure, private pampering!

Flavour Profile - Delicately floral on the nose and palate, with subtle herbal undertones and a fruity fizz

Ingredients - Whitley Neill Parma Violet Gin, Everleaf Mountain, Jasmine Syrup, Rose Shrub, Rhubarb Lemonade

THE ACTORS MUSE



Nestled in the West End, Strand Palace has long been part of Theatreland's backstage tradition - a place where actors and audiences alike gathered before the curtain call. From screen legends like Charlie Chaplin and Vivien Leigh to hopefuls chasing their big break, many began their evening at Gin Palace. Some settled their nerves with coffee; others added whisky for a touch of Dutch courage.

Flavour Profile - Bold coffee and smooth whiskey take centre stage, with subtle smokiness and a slight citrus note on the finish

Ingredients - Woodford Reserve Whiskey, Coffee Liqueur, Vanilla Syrup, Orange Bitters

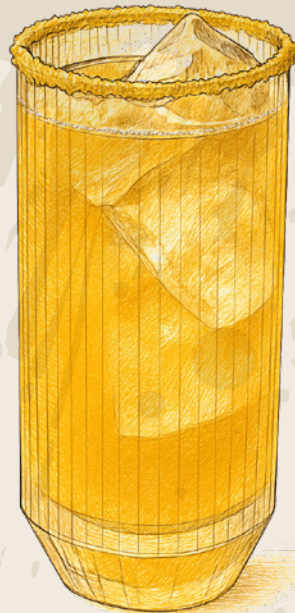
THE STRAND PALACE

At the heart of London since its grand Edwardian debut in 1909, Strand Palace has seen it all. Six monarchs, two world wars and countless moments in history. This cocktail is a celebration of that rich history and the hotel's transformation from past to present.

Flavour Profile - Rich and bold, with a depth of darker spirits, brightened by a zesty orange twist and lifted by a refreshing ginger fizz

Ingredients - Havana 7, Hayman Sloe Gin, Tequila Gold, Drambuie, Courvoisier, Lime Juice, Mandarin and Ginger Soda

CHUNEE THE ELEPHANT

Mocktail

Long before it became a hotel, the site of Strand Palace was home to Gilbert Pidcock's famous Menagerie, a travelling zoo that eventually found its permanent spot on the Strand. The upper floors housed lions, tigers, monkeys, and an elephant named Chune, whose wild spirit nearly led to a dramatic escape. A fashionable hotspot for society, the Menagerie even attracted visits from members of the Royal Family.

Flavour Profile - Pineapple sweetness, balanced by the warmth of ginger and a refreshing herbal hint of basil

Ingredients - Everleaf Marine, Basil Syrup, Pineapple Juice, Ginger Syrup, Lime

R&R

Mocktail

During World War II, Strand Palace became the go-to spot for US Army troops on their rest and recuperation (R&R) between missions. The hotel's lower ground floor turned into a safe haven during air raids, while upstairs, soldiers enjoyed hearty British meals and some well-earned downtime.

Flavour Profile - Light, refreshing and fizzy with a subtle zing of pink grapefruit and herbal finish

Ingredients - Everleaf Mountain, Raspberry Syrup, Elderflower, Sugar, Pink Grapefruit Soda

Complex and powerful, this Champagne uses a high proportion of reserve wine in the blend and is aged for significantly longer than required. Flavours of orange peel, spice and burnt butter.

SPARKLING WINE

Touch of Sparkle

A great English Sparkling wine, Chapel Down Sparkling Bacchus displaying aromas of pineapple, grapefruit and elderflower. The palate is tropical and floral with a crisp texture and a refreshing finish.

Pale light-yellow colour with delicate bubbles. An aromatic nose of wild apple with hints of honey and floral notes. Light-bodied and well-balanced, this is a perfect aperitif.

Pale pink in colour and with a delicate but complex nose of red fruit and citrus. There are fine bubbles on the palate and fruity notes of white peach, green apple and lemon.

LIGHT, CRISP AND VIBRANT

Sea Change Wine not only tastes good—it does good. Each bottle supports global ocean conservation, with 25p donated to marine charities. Minimal packaging cuts waste, helping reduce plastic pollution. Small choices, like the wine you drink, can make a big difference.

The nose shows delicate floral aromas and a hint of citrus. On the palate, the same citrus notes are present, resulting in a crisp and refreshing white.

Sauvignon Blanc, 'Parlez Vous'

Very expressive with floral notes evolving into aromas of exotic fruit. Fresh, full and well-balanced with an expressive finish and a slight return of exotic fruit and floral zests.

Early harvesting of grapes gives this wine a real bright freshness with flavours of tropical fruit and citrus. On the palate there's ripe fruit flavours and a delicate natural effervescence.

FRESH AND AROMATIC

Pale yellow in the glass, there are tropical aromas of pineapple and coconut with a hint of grapefruit. On the palate is fresh and fruity with more citrus flavours and a hint of coconut.

Sauvignon Blanc, Turtle Bay

This wine is fresh and vibrant with passion fruit, gooseberry and some melon characters. It has a balanced richness of fruit with a floral note through the palate, intense depth of flavour and a crisp finish.

Muscadet Sevre et Maine Sue Lie, La Sablette

Dry, pale yellow; the bouquet is dominated by aromas of lemon and completed by mineral notes. Round and refreshing in the mouth, medium-bodied and elegant.

The nose is full of inviting aromas like white peach and blossom, leading on to a mid-bodied palate with more citrus notes, a rounded and slightly oily texture and a long, mineral finish.
