CRAFT COCKTAILS

THE STRAND SOCIETY | £16

Courvoisier, Crème de Figue, Rose Shrub, Avera, Spicy Mango

A tribute to the Strand Palace's glittering social past, The Strand Society captures the warmth and quiet glamour of an era when London's cultural elite gathered behind its doors. Once frequented by legends such as Charlie Chaplin and Vivien Leigh, it celebrates the moments when conversation lingered long into the evening and the true theatre unfolded among friends.

Flavour Profile: *Bold yet harmonious cocktail: fruity, herbal and slightly floral, with a warming, bittersweet finish that unfolds sip by sip.*



THE TIMELESS PALACE | £17

Ketel One Vodka, Bénédictine, Coconut Syrup, Pineapple and Ginger Shrub, Red Bull Watermelon

Despite continual reinvention, from its Edwardian beginnings in 1909 and the glamour of 1928 to post-war renewal and later modernisations, Strand Palace has remained a constant in London's ever-changing story. Never closing its doors, it has quietly witnessed the city's evolution, welcoming generations who have passed through its halls.

Flavour Profile: *Light, zesty, and aromatic with a crisp tropical finish and a soft herbal backbone.*



STORYTELLER'S SIP | £15

Bacardi, Cacacha, Midori, Sugar, Lime and Tajín Rim

Published from 1891 to 1950, The Strand Magazine turned everyday London into a literary hotspot. The popularity of Sherlock Holmes became widespread after first appearing in its pages, with the magazine amassing half a million eager readers. This cocktail is a tribute to that golden age of storytelling, a toast to the narratives that made The Strand come to life.

Flavour Profile: Fresh, juicy, and slightly exotic, the profile leans towards a crisp, fruit-forward finish with a refreshing tang and a soft, lingering sweetness.



THE QUIET INFUSION | £17

Maker's Mark, Bulleit Whiskey, Ginger Syrup, Lime, Strand Palace Blend Tea, Brown Sugar Rim

In the early 1700s, a small tea trade began along the Strand, introducing Londoners to a new daily ritual. What started as an exotic import quickly became a symbol of pause, conversation, and refinement. Over time, tea shaped how the city gathered and unwound, with the Strand at the heart of its rise. This cocktail celebrates that quiet moment when London learned to slow down.

Flavour Profile: Finished with a brown sugar rim and dried lime garnish, the cocktail delivers a sweet-spiced opening, a vibrant citrus lift, and a long, warming finish with hints of tea, spice, and caramelised depth.



1909 | £18

Strand Palace Gin, Tanqueray, Raspberry Syrup, Elderflower Cordial, Cranberry Juice, Pink Grapefruit Soda

In Edwardian London, a grand new hotel opened its doors on the Strand in 1909. Five shillings and sixpence got you a room and breakfast. Since then, we've seen monarchs crowned, wars fought, and decades of guests pass through - artists, icons, dreamers, and doers. This cocktail celebrates where it all started: one address, over a century of stories, and a city we'll never stop raising a glass to.

Flavour Profile: Bright and refreshing, with fresh berries, citrus and Strand's own signature gin.



MURDER MYSTERY | £16

Ciroc Apple Vodka, Ciroc Vodka, Raspberry Syrup, Elderflower Cordial, Cranberry Juice Bitters

In the post-war 1940s, Strand Palace found itself in the middle of a real-life murder mystery. Staff burst into a room to find Neville Heath standing over a distressed young woman named Pauline. Months later, when Heath was arrested for a separate murder, staff mistakenly identified the victim as Pauline - a twist that added confusion (and headlines) to one of London's most notorious true crime tales.

Flavour Profile: Light, refreshing and fruity with a subtle floral finish.

THE POWDER ROOM | £18

Whitley Neill Parma Violet Gin, Everleaf Mountain, Jasmine Syrup, Apple Juice, Rose Shrub, Rhubarb Lemonade, Lime Juice, Bitters

In 1958, Strand Palace gave London hospitality a glow-up, becoming one of the first hotels in the city to offer en-suite bathrooms. No more hallway dashes in a robe to use the shared bathrooms on each floor – just the luxury of pure, private pampering!

Flavour Profile: *Delicately floral on the nose and palate, with subtle herbal undertones and a fruity fizz.*



THEATRELAND AFTER DARK | £15

Woodford Reserve Whiskey, Coffee Liqueur, Vanilla Syrup, Orange Bitters

Nestled in the West End, Strand Palace has long been part of Theatreland's backstage tradition – a place where actors and audiences alike gathered before the curtain call. From screen legends like Charlie Chaplin and Vivien Leigh to hopefuls chasing their big break, many began their evening at Gin Palace. Some settled their nerves with coffee; others added whiskey for a touch of Dutch courage.

Flavour Profile: *Bold coffee and smooth whiskey take centre stage, with subtle smokiness and a slight sweet and citrus note on the finish.*



GRAND TANGO | £17

Ketel One Vodka, Frangelico, Crème de Coco, Double Crème, Baileys, Caramelised Hazelnuts

During the roaring 1920s, the hotel became a known venue for London's elite, famous for glamorous dances including the Charleston and Tango held in its vast public rooms.

Flavour Profile: *Rich, smooth, nutty and unmistakably hedonistic, the finish is long and mellow with lingering hints of praline and sweet cream.*



STRAND PALACE | £18

Havana 7, Hayman's Sloe Gin, Tequila Gold, Drambuie, Courvoisier, Lime Juice, Mandarin and Ginger Soda

At the heart of London since its grand Edwardian debut in 1909, Strand Palace has seen it all. Six monarchs, two world wars and countless moments in history. This cocktail is a celebration of that rich history and hotel's transformation from past to present.

Flavour Profile: *Rich and bold, with a depth of darker spirits, brightened by a zesty orange twist and lifted by a refreshing ginger fizz.*



MOCKTAILS

COVENT GARDEN

Everleaf Marine, Blue Curaçao Syrup, Banana Syrup, Coconut Syrup, Rhubarb Lemonade

By the 18th century, Covent Garden had become the heart of London's food trade, with its bustling fruit and vegetable market attracting merchants and shoppers from across the city. Alongside the market, coffee houses, taverns, and theatres helped shape a neighbourhood known for its energy and character. A refined, story-driven mocktail inspired by this vibrant era, where garden produce meets global discovery.

Flavour Profile: *Lively, diverse, and ever evolving, with flavours that feel both rooted in British tradition and touched by distant shores.*



NUMBER 1 STRAND

Seedlip Spice, Homemade Thyme Syrup, Lavender Syrup, Lime, Raspberry Lemonade

The first numbered address in London was on the strand. It was the first building in London to have a street number. It was the official residence of the secretary of state during the reign of Charles II between 1660-1685. The building no longer exists but the address does.

Flavour Profile: *An elegant, softly aromatic mocktail with a graceful balance of floral lift and gentle herbaceous depth, offering a refined and contemporary palate.*

Franklin & Sons Rhubarb & Hibiscus Tonic, Seasonal Berries

Tanqueray Blackcurrant Royale Gin blends the bold character of Tanqueray with rich blackcurrant and subtle floral notes for an aromatic twist on a classic serve.

OPIHR | £15

Franklin & Sons Indian Tonic, Lime & Pink Peppercorn

A bold and aromatic spiced gin layered with warm notes of cardamom, black pepper and citrus. Served with crisp Indian tonic, fresh lime and pink peppercorn for a vibrant, exotic finish.

Franklin & Sons Mallorcan Tonic, Orange and Star Anise

Sapling Climate Positive Gin blends bright citrus, delicate botanicals and subtle spice, served with Mallorcan tonic, fresh orange and star anise for a crisp, fragrant finish.

HAYMAN'S OLD TOM | £15

Franklin & Sons Mallorcan Tonic, Dry Mango and Lime

Hayman's Old Tom is a botanically rich, subtly sweet gin that became the go-to pour of the 19th century, perfect for those who enjoy a smoother serve.

SILENT POOL | £17

Franklin & Sons Elderflower and Cucumber Tonic, Cucumber and Lemon

Silent Pool Gin combines fresh floral notes with layered citrus and subtle spice, served with elderflower & cucumber tonic, cucumber and lemon for a light, crisp finish.

THE BOTANIST | £16

Franklin & Sons Light Tonic, Dry Orange and Mint

Smooth, floral and refreshing, The Botanist Islay Dry Gin pairs effortlessly with light tonic, while dried orange and mint enhance its bright citrus character and layered botanical finish.

Complex and powerful, this Champagne uses a high proportion of reserve wine in the blend and is aged for significantly longer than required. Flavours of orange peel, spice and burnt butter.

Pale pink in colour and with a delicate but complex nose of red fruit and citrus. There are fine bubbles on the palate and fruity notes of white peach, green apple and lemon.

LIGHT, CRISP & VIBRANT

Sauvignon Blanc, 'Parlez Vous' £9.5 £13 £38
Maison Lacheteau, VDF France. 12%

Very expressive with floral notes evolving into aromas of exotic fruit. Fresh, full and well balanced with an expressive finish and a slight return of exotic fruit and floral zests.

Vinho Verde, Janelas Antigas Grande Escolha £9.5 £13 £37
Casa De Vila Verde, Portugal. 11.5% (PB)

Early harvesting of grapes gives this wine a real bright freshness with flavours of tropical fruit and citrus. On the palate there's ripe fruit flavours and a delicate natural effervescence.

Pinot Grigio, Sea Change £9 £12 £34
Terre di Chieti, Italy. 11% (PB)

Each bottle supports global ocean conservation, with 25p donated to marine charities. Minimal packaging cuts waste, helping reduce plastic pollution. Small choices, like the wine you drink, can make a big difference. The nose shows delicate floral aromas and a hint of citrus. On the palate, the same citrus notes are present, resulting in a crisp and refreshing white. Light bodied and well balanced, this is a perfect apéritif.

FRESH AND AROMATIC

Sauvignon Blanc, Turtle Bay £12 £16 £45
Marlborough, New Zealand. 12%

This wine is fresh and vibrant with passion fruit, gooseberry and some melon characters. It has a balanced richness of fruit with a floral note through the palate, intense depth of flavour and a crisp finish.

Muscadet Sèvre et Maine Sur Lie, La Sablette £45
Loire, France. 12%

Dry, pale yellow; the bouquet is dominated by aromas of lemon and completed by mineral notes. Round and refreshing in the mouth, medium-bodied and elegant.

Rioja Blanco, Viña Cerrada, Bodegas Ugdale £40
Rioja, Spain. 12.5% (PB)

Pale yellow in the glass, there are tropical aromas of pineapple and coconut with a hint of grapefruit. On the palate is fresh and fruity with more citrus flavours and a hint of coconut.

The nose is full of inviting aromas like white peach and blossom, leading on to a mid-bodied palate with more citrus notes, a rounded and slightly oily texture and a long, mineral finish.

California, USA. 13%

A fabulous balance of refreshing citrus and tropical fruit flavours with just a hint of vanilla on the finish.

Provence, France. 12.5%

A dreamy soft pink colour. Elegant and fine flavoured red berries with a hint of spice. Lots of finesse, a truly delightful wine.

Zinfandel Rosé, Charlie Zin £9 £12 £34
California, USA. 10.5%

Fruity and fresh with flavours of red fruit and hints of spices. Rich in flavour, this wine has a rounded mouthfeel and a long finish.

Rosato, Solino £9 £12 £34
Italy. 11%

This pale rosé wine is delicate and dry with subtle flavours of white peach and redcurrant.
